## Priming of Intrafix<sup>®</sup> SafeSet with Caresite<sup>®</sup>



Peel off the covering foil of the port and disinfect if necessary.



Remove the protective cap from the spike.



Insert the spike at a vertical angle. Avoid rotating the spike when piercing. Use the green mark as finger stopper.



Close the roller clamp and hang the container on the stand.





Squeeze the drip chamber and set the fluid level up to the ring of the drip chamber. When using collapsible containers like Ecoflac<sup>®</sup> plus, keep the venting cap closed. With glass bottles, open the venting cap.



Open the roller clamp and prime the IV administration set. Attach the patient connector to the hook of the roller clamp.



Disinfect the top of the Caresite® Y-Site per national and /or institutional protocol.



Kink the IV tubing below the Caresite® Y-Site and remove air from the IV set with a luer compatible syringe.

Priming of Caresite<sup>®</sup> – Version B (IV tubing is primed up to the Caresite<sup>®</sup> Y-Site)



Reduce the flowrate and prime the Y-Site slowly.



Retrograde Priming: Hold the Caresite<sup>®</sup> upside down and remove the air by flipping with your finger against the valve.



Close the roller clamp.



The priming process is done and the Intrafix<sup>®</sup> SafeSet is ready to connect to the patient.
